ROAD WORKS ALONG BRADING MAIN ROAD

PROJECT SUMMARY

The dates and information below are subject to pending final permit approval from Island Roads.

Our contractors plan to begin work along the main road through Brading in January aiming to start on 3rd January 2023 with work continuing until our target end date of 18th May 2023.

Other work is also going on in various side roads in the Brading and other areas but this document relates to work on the main road through Brading only.

Our Planners and Contractors have worked closely with Island Roads and Isle of Wight Council to ensure that the plan for these works involves as little disruption as possible and is completed as quickly and efficiently as possible. To achieve this we will have to work into the late evening.

During the works there will be traffic management in place with temporary traffic lights being deployed and, when necessary, the road will be closed in the evenings only – never during the day. Diversions when the road is closed will use a route as approved by Island Roads.

Pedestrian routes along pavements will be modified and diverted as necessary and the existing pedestrian crossings and traffic lights will be disabled and moved/modified as necessary.

Road users are requested to please try to avoid the area and use an alternative route if at all possible.

INFORMING THE PUBLIC

A public meeting will be held at 18:00 on Monday December 5th, in Brading Town Hall.

We will issue a press release to local media giving details of the public meeting.

Local Parish/Town Councils will be provided with details of our plans and asked to assist with distributing this information to communities.

ACCESS FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES AND BUSES

Access for emergency services is a priority and will always be facilitated.

Bus Services will be re-routed and altered, with new temporary bus stops installed where required. A bus service will be maintained, however there will be changes to routes and schedules and these will be determined by the bus operators who will notify us of their plans in due course. We will provide this information to the public as soon as we receive it.

DISABLED ACCESS

Our teams will be on hand to react and solve any requests for disabled access or assistance.
